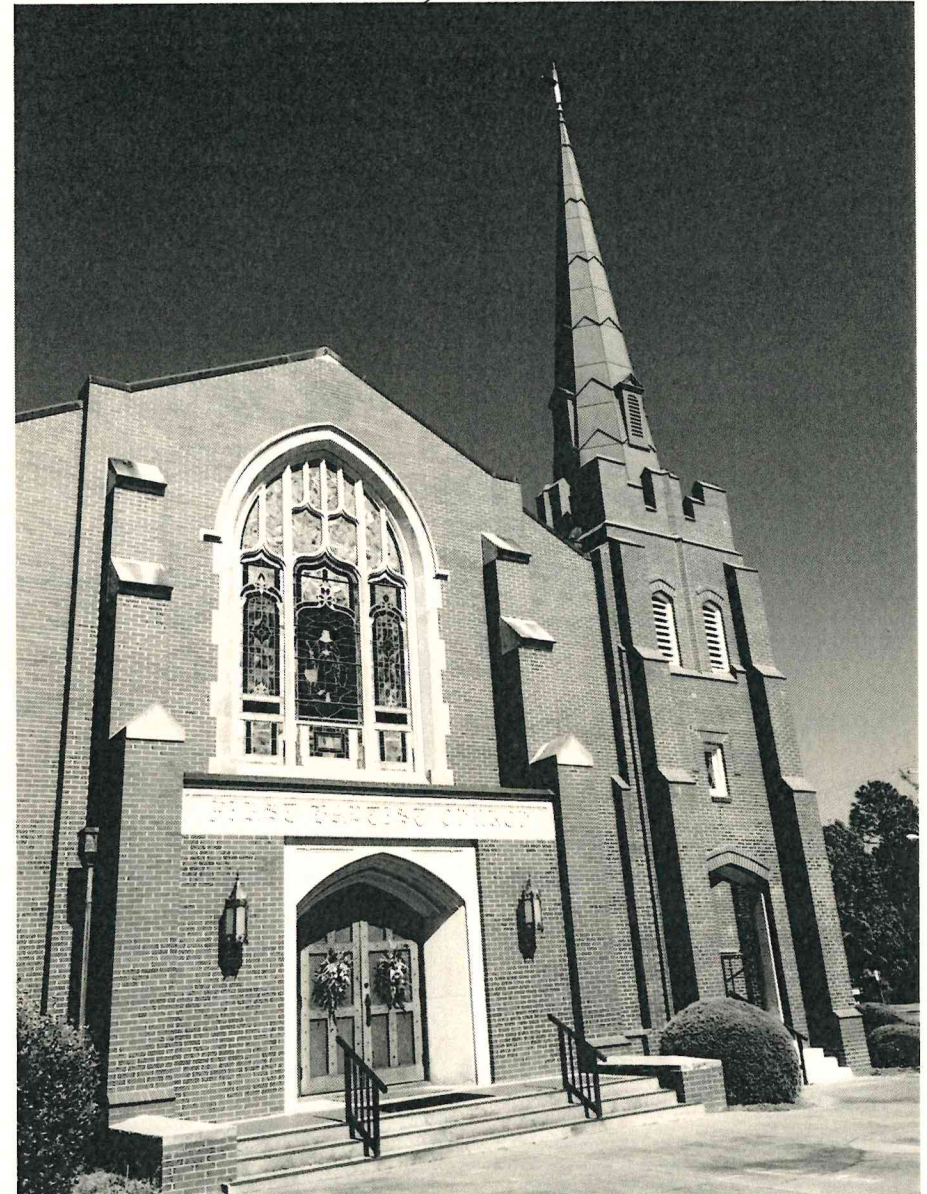

Points of Application:

1. Examine what you are tolerating.

Is there anything in your life that God's Word clearly calls sin but that you have learned to excuse?

2. Don't settle for a Christian reputation.

Being known as a Christian is not the same thing as walking with Christ.

3. Be faithful with whatever strength God has given you.

You do not have to be prominent to be useful to God.

4. Guard against spiritual self-sufficiency.

The more comfortable we become, the easier it can be to forget how desperately we need the Lord.

5. Remember that Christ's correction is an expression of His love.

"Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline."

His correction is intended to bring His people to repentance and restoration.

6. Keep listening to what the Spirit says to the churches.

Each letter concludes with essentially the same call:

"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

The question is not simply, "What did Jesus say to them?"

The question is: "What is Jesus saying to us?"
